WHAT DOES Axia Financial LLC (Axia) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:
	" Social Security number and income and assets
	Payment history and account balances
	Credit worthiness and credit history
	When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Axia chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Axia does not share your information with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Axia does not engage in joint marketing.
